

Cookie Policy

A Cookie is a small text file that is downloaded onto your device when you access a website. It allows that website to recognise your device and share information about your preferences or past actions.

Cookies allow us to see which pages have been viewed and how frequently they have been visited. Cookies also help us to make our website more efficient and user friendly.

Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you may have set up your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie which will give you the opportunity to refuse it. If you disallow such cookies, then you may not be able to access all features of our website.

Our website uses the following types of cookie:

Necessary Cookies – we use these to ensure you can see basic functions like page functionality and access to secure areas of the website, such as our Online Resource Centre. Our website will not function correctly without these cookies.

Preference Cookies - these allow a website to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like a preferred language or the region that you are in.

Analytics Cookies - these help us understand how you interact with our websites by collecting and reporting information anonymously. They also allow us to focus on improving certain parts of our website to provide a better and more useful experience.
